Not all new racquets come out of the factory perfectly weighted or balanced; sometimes discrepancies of up to 20 – 30 grams can appear in the same racquet. It's times like these that professional stringers can customise racquets right down to the gram giving them perfect balance, weight and allowing a player to simply transition from one racquet to the other, seamlessly.

Same racquets, but they feel totally different?



Some player can carry up to 6 racquets in their tennis bag going into a match. But what would happen if the player was to break a string mid-match and needs to swap a racquet? Are his or her racquets identical? Are they evenly balanced? Are they the same weight? Are they even the same swing-weight?

Players are able to feel the difference between 1 ~ 2 pounds in tension. Now add a 15 gram weight variation, which has in-turn shifted the balance out by 10mm which has now thrown off the Swing-Weight by several degrees. Not only must the player be content with tension variation, but they're fighting a different beast and must try and quickly adjust their game to the suit the different racquets with different playing characteristics. This can lead to player's miss hitting and costing them vital points or at worst play on their mind and ruin their entire game.

Players need to confidently and know that their racquets are all finely tuned and working in sync from string tension to racquet balance, to weight and swing-weight. With an Xtreme Dyno Tune Machine, pro-shop owners can now add racquet customisation to their artillery and set themselves apart from other tennis shops while drawing a larger clientele and customer base for a more professional service.
